5 He stooped and looked in and saw the linen wrappings lying there, but he didn't go in.


























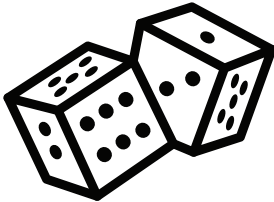


The soldiers twisted thorns together to make a crown. They put it on Jesus' head. Then they put a purple robe on Him. John 19:2 Nlrv

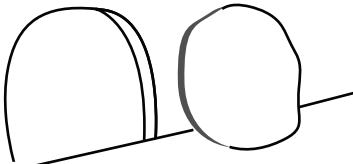

Then they divided up His clothes. They cast lots to see what each of them would get. Mark 15:24b Nlrv

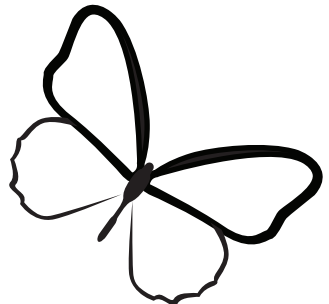
