- I will uphold Celebrate Recovery's small group guidelines.
- I will pray for the unity, health, and growth of this ministry and Brookwood Church.
- I will regularly serve at Brookwood Celebrate Recovery.
- I will regularly attend the monthly Celebrate Recovery Leaders Meetings.
- As a leader in Celebrate Recovery, I will develop, encourage and identify new potential leaders. I will also be willing to actively mentor a leadership apprentice.
- I will take personal responsibility for how I represent Celebrate Recovery and Brookwood Church in the community and on social media.
- I understand that as a leader, I represent both the church and this ministry. I will uphold the teachings of Christ in the way I live my life and will avoid the appearance of impropriety.
- I am willing to let other leaders or T.E.A.M. members speak into my life if they are concerned for my wellbeing or overall recovery.
- I agree to serve in a leadership role for a minimum of one year or the end of my step study (barring unforeseen emergencies or life circumstances) and am dedicated to helping create a smooth transition when God leads me in a new direction.
- I will squelch gossip, reject divisive behavior and resolve conflict with love and truth by applying Matthew 18:15-17 and encourage others to do the same.

"If another believer sins against you, go privately and point out the offense. If the other person listens and confesses it, you have won that person back. But if you are unsuccessful, take one or two others with you and go back again, so that everything you say may be confirmed by two or three witnesses. If the person still refuses to listen, take your case to the church. Then if he or she won't accept the church's decision, treat that person as a pagan or a corrupt tax collector."
