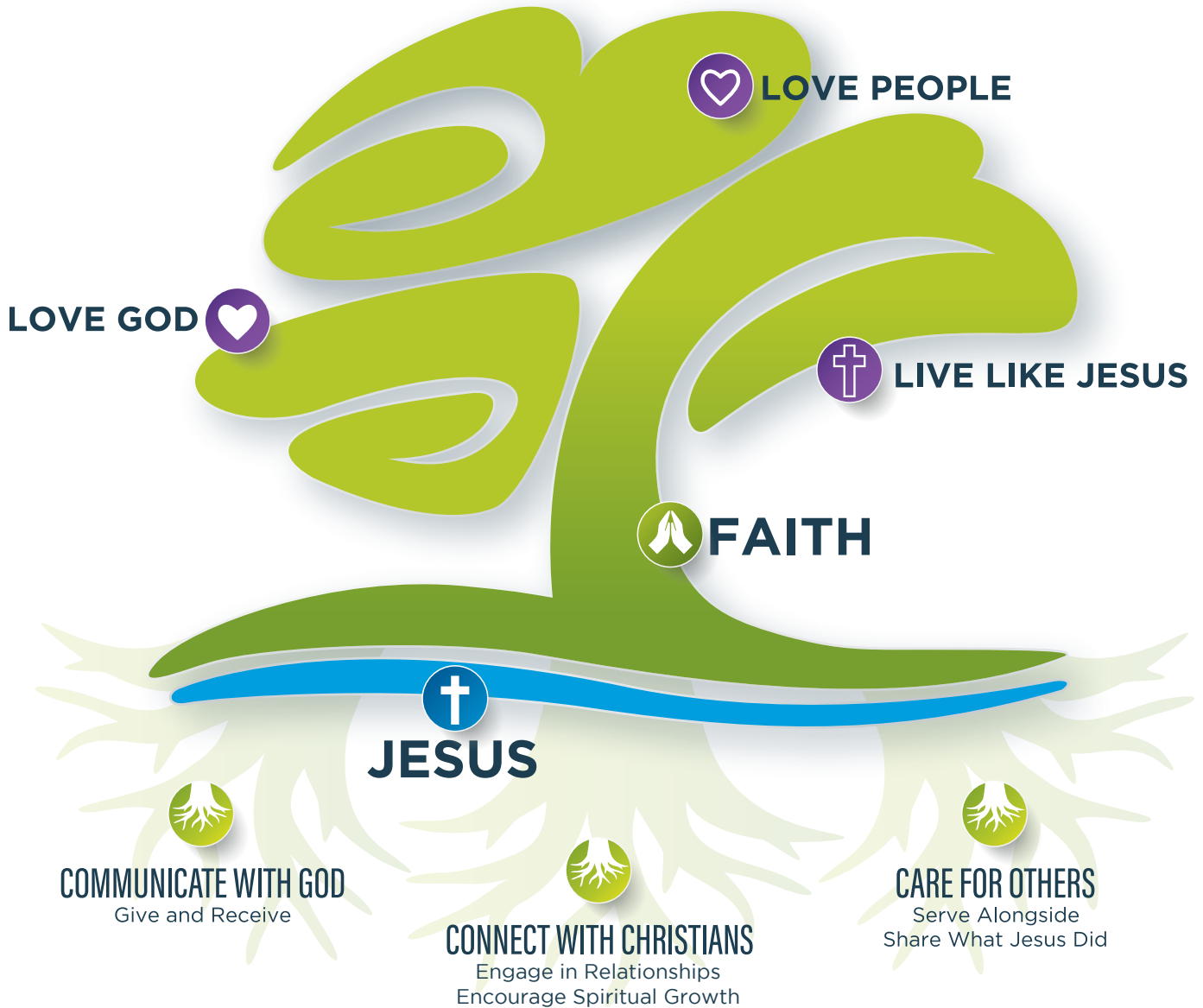

We pray this helps people experience a transformed life of loving God, loving people and living like Jesus.

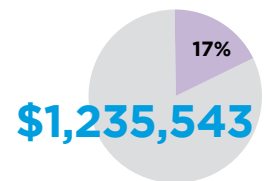
WORSHIP Communicating with God

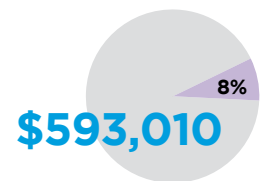
ADULT DISCIPLESHIP | RECREATION Connecting with Christians

BECAUSE OF YOUR GIVING

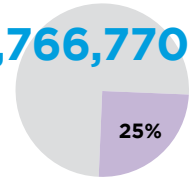
BECAUSE OF YOUR GIVING

- An average of 1,008 children and students participated in Sunday programming.

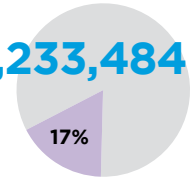
BECAUSE OF YOUR GIVING

- Over 320 volunteers demonstrated care at least 14,026 times.
- 1,492 encouraging cards were sent in response to prayer requests.
- Celebrate Recovery witnessed salvations and continued fellowship online during COVID-19.
- A new Connections Team encouraged Online Campus attendees.
- Calling campaigns ensured connection with Congregants without email or Internet during COVID-19.

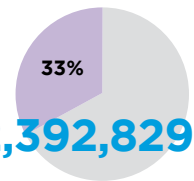
BECAUSE OF YOUR GIVING

- Families with special needs children were shown love through respite times for parents while children enjoyed engaging activities.
- Brookwood provided funds for Set Free to care for over 1,000 of the 10,000 rescued children in India.
- 24 Global Partners received support.
- 217 water wells were drilled to provide clean water for over 262,000 people in India, Liberia, and Sierra Leone through our partnership with the Set Free Water of Life Initiative.

- Help launch programs for overcoming addiction in Latvia.

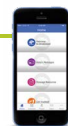
