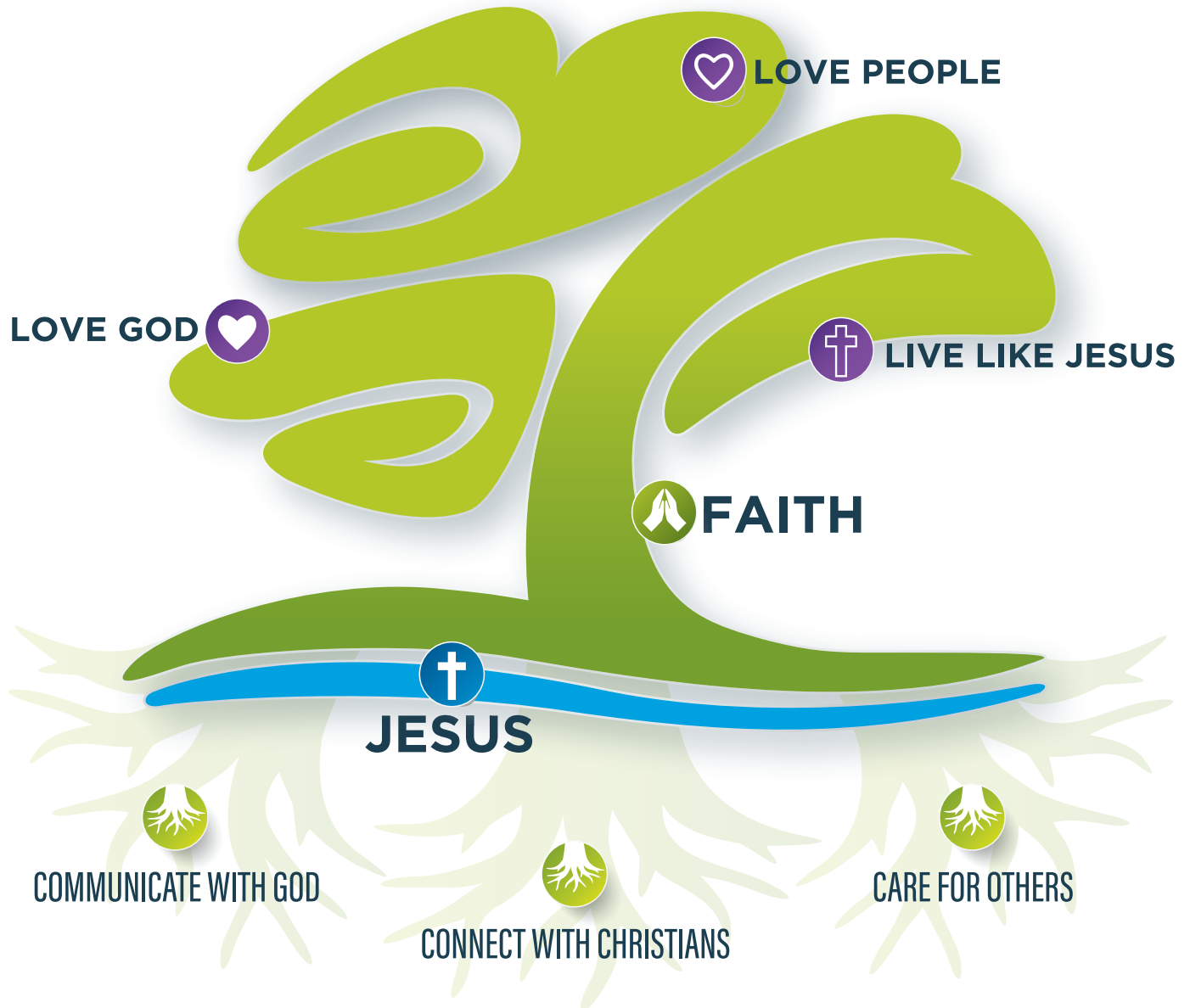

We pray this helps people experience a transformed life of loving God, loving people and living like Jesus.

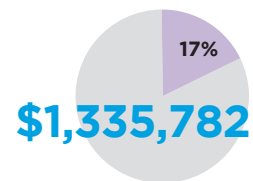
WORSHIP Communicating with God

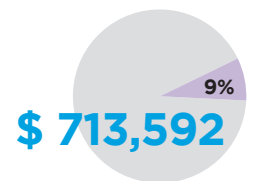
ADULT DISCIPLESHIP | RECREATION Connecting with Christians

BECAUSE OF YOUR GIVING

- 133 adults participated in the Essentials discipleship program.
- 1,120 adults connected in 94 Community Groups.
- 475 attended Connecting Points.
- 111 participated in classes and seminars.
- 389 ladies attended the Women's Conference onsite.
- 120 adults participated in mentoring.
- Over 1,000 youth and adults participated in Recreation.

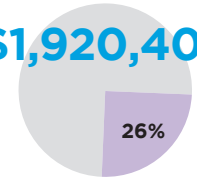
BECAUSE OF YOUR GIVING

Caring for Others at Brookwood

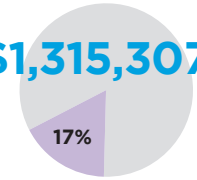
BECAUSE OF YOUR GIVING

- 7 staff, 345 volunteers and 23 Ministries demonstrated care.
- Staff and volunteers assisted with home projects and provided financial mentoring to 129 people.
- The Intercessory Prayer Team responded to over 2015 requests with prayer cards.
- Guests and family were welcomed and encouraged at the Online Campus.
- Community events for schools, the sheriff's office, and a local funeral home were hosted onsite.

Caring for Others in our Community and the World

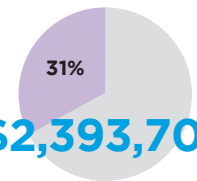
BECAUSE OF YOUR GIVING

- Brookwood provided funds for Set Free to care for over 1,000 of the 7,721 rescued children in India.
- Staff provided Pastor Training in Uganda and Liberia.
- Through our Set Free Water of Life Initiative partnership, 36 new water wells now provide clean water in India, Sierra Leone and Liberia.
- 24 Global Partners received support.
- Special Friends hosted an Adventure Week and Fun Fridays for the special needs community.

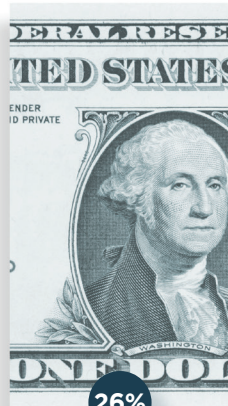
HOW EVERY DOLLAR IS DISTRIBUTED
