#### **Car Line**

- When we start to load, please refrain from using your cell phone.
- Wait until the car in front of you pulls away before you pull away from the curb.
- Our staff is not allowed to load or buckle in your child.



### Weather

As the days get cooler, we'll still go out to the playground daily. So please check the daily weather and dress your child appropriately.

## **Clothes**

As the weather cools off, please send in some winter clothes for us to keep at school. We'll send home your summer clothes.

#### Lunch

At Brookwood Preschool Academy we're striving to give your child the very best school experience possible. When it comes to your child's lunch, we ask that you thoughtfully choose the items packed for them to eat, keeping in mind the number of sugary items that are included. Good classroom behavior is a very important part of our day, and when sugar has been a large part of a meal, it's hard to sit still and have good behavior. NO candy please. Send heatable items in plastic microwave-ready containers. Glass containers, Ziploc bags and foil are not allowed. We're also unable to heat Lunchables.

# Spoons/Forks

Please remember to pack a spoon or fork in your child's lunch if needed. The Academy does not provide these items.

## **Rainy Days**

On rainy days please feel free to have your child walk into school with an umbrella if you wish. However, please take the umbrella with you when you leave. We do not want anyone to get hurt, and umbrellas tend to cause problems. Also, if rain boots are worn to school they'll need to stay on your child for the day at all times. You are welcome to send in an extra set of shoes.

## **Back Packs**

Please send your child to school with an empty backpack. We're trying to teach independence to your child. It can be very frustrating for a child to put items into a backpack that's already full. This is something they need to master before going to public school. Our staff will take out extra clothing you send in and keep it here at school. Toys should be left in the car or at home. Also, please don't leave any medications in your child's backpack. Please bring them to the office or take them with you. Thank you in advance for your help with this.

# **Cell Phone**

Keep in mind that the Academy is a cell phone free zone. While you're here it's a time for us to communicate with you and for your child to say their goodbyes in the morning. In the afternoons your child is excited to see you, and we'd like to communicate with you about your child's day.
