Bible Study and Group Discussion

Read [Isaiah 9:1-7](#).

1. What do you think the emotional atmosphere was like for God's people during this time?
2. What specific promises are given in this passage?
3. Which of these promises brings you the most encouragement? Why?
4. Isaiah tells the Israelites a child would be born. Why would this have been important to them?

Read [Luke 1:26-38](#).

5. According to this passage, how does Jesus fulfill the promises given in [Isaiah 9:1-7](#)?
6. What does it mean to you that God reigns?

7. Describe a time you submitted to God's authority.
8. How has God becoming flesh changed the way you live?
9. Jesus is called *Mighty God*. How might this impact the way you pray?
10. Describe how this changes the way you relate with others?
11. What can you do to make Christmas more meaningful this year?
12. What's your biggest takeaway from this week's lesson?

Each day this week, ask God to fill you with hope and strength. Ask Him to show you His power and glory as you reflect on Jesus as *Mighty God*.
