 - I'm clear about God's purpose for my life and am living it out.

Based on your response, what do you feel is your best next step?

4. Describe a time you experienced God's Spirit leading you.
5. Have you ever been confused about what God wanted you to do in a particular situation? If so, what did you do?

6. Whose faith inspires you to grow closer to God? Give an example of something they've done.
7. What impression of God do you get from this week's passage?
8. What questions does this passage raise for you?
9. From what you've learned about Paul in this week's lesson, what's one way you can follow his example?
