Conversation Starter

Have you ever been able to instantly recognize the voice of a loved one even in the midst of a noisy crowd? If so, describe the situation.

Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

Read [John 10:22-42](#) (Reading #128 in *The Life of Jesus*).

1. Did the Jews truly want to know if Jesus was the Messiah ([vs. 22-24](#))?
2. In what specific ways—earlier in His ministry—had Jesus already clearly told the people whether or not He was the Messiah ([vs. 25](#))?
3. Why did Jesus tell them they weren't His sheep ([vs. 26](#))?
4. What's true of Jesus' sheep ([vs. 27](#))?

The sheep have only one important trait, but it is the only one they need: They listen to the voice of the Shepherd.

5. What has been your experience hearing the voice of Jesus?
6. How can you know if what you're hearing is from God?
7. How convinced are you that Jesus is God? What are the main reasons you believe that He is or is not God? Do you think someone could ever talk you out of that belief ([vs. 28-30](#))?

8. Why did the Jews pick up rocks to stone Jesus ([vs. 31-33](#))?
9. Jesus answered them in [vs. 34-39](#) by quoting [Psalm 82](#). What do you think He was trying to say?
10. How is true belief displayed in [vs. 40-42](#)?
11. List several things that are true about Jesus from this passage.
12. Which of these truths is most significant for you right now, and how do you think Jesus wants you to respond?

Soul Training

Keep yourself open to God with **Fixed-Hour Prayer**—Plan a schedule that fits well in your day, pausing at appointed times to pray for several minutes. Determining ahead of time when you will meet with God is a great way to care for your soul.
