LIVE IT

God called Paul to share the Good News. It's easy to look at his journeys to places like Thessalonica, Berea and Athens and believe that we couldn't do anything like that. But, God has called each of us to live as ambassadors on His behalf. Empowered by the Holy Spirit, know that you CAN do it!

In each of the cities Paul visited in Acts 17, he ran into opposition. He was mocked, and other times he fled for his safety. But in addition to pushback, Paul found many who were interested in hearing about Jesus. When we faithfully share the Good News, God draws people to Himself. We're responsible for sharing, but we're not responsible for how people respond. We pray and trust God with that part.

Who in your life needs to hear the Good News? What's keeping you from sharing it with them? Set aside time to have intentional, Jesus-centered conversations with them.
