

Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

Jesus often confronted death and the pain it brings into our lives. In John <u>11:1-44</u>, He comes to a grieving woman with a startling word of hope.

Read <u>John 11:1-27</u>.

1. From what you've read in this passage, how would you describe the relationship between Jesus and Martha?

Between Jesus and Lazarus?

- 2. What is Jesus' response when He first hears that Lazarus is sick? What's your reaction to His response?
- 3. Jesus told them a strange saying in <u>vs. 9-10</u>. What point was Jesus trying to make?
- 4. What do you think Martha had in mind when she said, "...But even now I know that God will give You whatever You ask." (vs. 22)?
- 5. What does Jesus mean when He says, *"Everyone who lives in Me and believes in Me will never ever die..."* (vs. 26)?

Read John 11:28-44.

- 6. When Jesus saw Mary and all the Judeans He experienced anger and compassion (vs. 33-35). Why is this? How does this challenge the way people including many Christians often understand God?
- 7. What are similarities and differences you notice between the story of the raising of Lazarus and that of Jesus' own resurrection (John 20:1-29)?
- 8. If Jesus is the resurrection and the life, how would you describe the life we have right now when we believe in Him?
- 9. How might this passage change the way you pray for those who are going through a difficult time?

10. What's your biggest takeaway from this week's teaching?
