# Family Talk – A Humbling Encounter

#### **READ TOGETHER**

### Matthew 3:11–17

- 2. If Jesus asked you to do something you didn't feel qualified to do, how would you respond?

## LIVE IT

The people had not heard from a prophet for over 400 years, so it was a big deal when John the Baptist got to the scene. His message, his authority, his baptism, and his obedience were what made John so great and strong in the faith. In verse 11, John recognized his position and considered himself "*not worthy even to be His slave*", but when Jesus arrived, He wanted John to baptize Him. How crazy is that?

Both John and Jesus were fully obedient. Jesus didn't sin. So He didn't need to be cleansed of sins through baptism. Yet He chose to be baptized for His Father (God) and as an example to us. John felt unqualified, but Jesus knew he was the man for the job. Do you ever feel like Jesus is pushing you in a direction? Are you being obedient to Him through serving, reading your Bible, giving your time and money, and through prayer?
