

The Bible Craft

What You Need: “The Bible Book” Activity Page, white copy paper, gold stickers (or draw a coin or jewels), heart stickers, smiley face stickers, and crayons. (If you don’t have stickers use your best drawing skills!)

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Print “The Bible Book” Activity Page onto copy paper. Fold the page in half and in half again to create a book. Place the stickers and crayons in the center of the table.

During the Activity: Give each child a folded “The Bible Book” Activity Page. Read the text on the front aloud to the children as they place gold stickers on the cover. Then instruct the children to open their books. Read the text on the left-hand side and encourage them to place a heart sticker on the second page.

Read the text on the right-hand side and instruct the children to draw a house on the page. And finally, flip to the back cover, read the text aloud, and encourage the children to place a smiley face sticker on the back.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: “We’ve learned so many amazing things from the Bible this month!

[Bottom Line] The Bible IS better than gold. Let’s make a book today to help us remember some of the things we’ve learned.”

After the Activity: “Friends, **[Bottom Line] the Bible is better than gold!** It tells me that God loves us so much He gave us Jesus. The Bible tells us how to live. And the Bible teaches me that I can share my stuff. You did an awesome job on these books. Let’s share what we’ve learned with our families this week. Tell me: **What is better than gold? [Bottom Line] The Bible is better than gold.**”
