- 3. What does the wicked Ninevites' response (see Jonah 1:2) teach us about our ability to be forgiven?

LIVE IT

Thank goodness we, like Jonah, are given second chances. After initially disobeying God and running in the opposite direction, spending time in the belly of a fish, and being spit out onto dry land, he goes to Nineveh. It was the last place he wanted to go, but obedience to God is vitally important.

When confronted with their sin, the Ninevites repent! Everyone from the greatest to the least believed God's message spoken by Jonah. The King of Nineveh commanded everyone to pray, turn from their evil ways, and stop all violence. Upon seeing their genuine change, God did not punish them. How encouraging!
