### **READ TOGETHER**

#### Isaiah 46:3-10

- 1. Verses 5-7 address false gods that people worship. We don't see many totems or statues in our society today, but there are still idols that some people worship. Can you name a few?
- 2. Verse 9 tells us to remember all the things God has done in the past. How have you seen God move in your life?
- 3. Verse 10 says that everything God plans will happen. Do you find this comforting? Why or why not?

# LIVE IT
