## **Discussion Guide**

Use this guide to help you draw closer to God. Try not to rush through these questions, but take time to learn and grow. Ask God to speak to you in His Word. Find a Small Group at <u>brookwoodchurch.org/smallgroups</u>.

#### **Conversation Starter**

What is one characteristic you received from your parents that you want to keep, and one you wish you could change?

#### **Personal Reflection/Group Discussion**

#### Read <u>John 14:15-31</u>

(Beginning with the second section of Reading #184 in The Life of Jesus).

- 1. Jesus says if we love Him we will keep His commands.
  - a. Locate at least three places in this passage where Jesus says this.
  - b. What does it mean to keep Jesus' commands?
  - c. Where else in the Bible can you find this principle (that *loving* God means *obeying* God)?
- 2. How would you describe the link between obedience and love? How do these fit/work together?
- 3. What would you say to someone who says *I've been saved by grace, I don't have to obey*?
- 4. How is the Spirit of God described in this passage?

- 5. What is the role of the Holy Spirit in our lives today? *See especially*: John 14:16-17, 26-27; 16:7-15; Romans 8:9-11, 14-16, 26-27.
- 6. What questions do you have about the Holy Spirit?
- 7. What is the most encouraging part of this week's teaching for you personally?

#### **Soul Training**

Find a quiet place and read John 14:15-27. As you read, make a list of all the promises Jesus makes to those who love Him. Which of these promises seem most significant to you right now? Talk with God about what you are experiencing as you study this passage. Ask Him to put in your mind what He wants you to know, then spend a few minutes in silence listening for Him to speak. Use this time to practice *receiving from God*.
