Family Talk - Return

READ TOGETHER

- 1 Samuel 7:1-17
- 1. What did the people have to do in order to return to God? (v.3-4)
- 2. Samuel set up a stone and called it Ebenezer, which means the stone of help (v. 12). Why do you think Samuel did this?

LIVE IT

Here we have a picture of what it really looks like to trust in God. The Israelites had to repent, destroy their foreign gods, turn their hearts to Him, and obey Him only. Is your family ruthlessly eliminating those things that distract from your relationship with God?
