Family Talk – Pursue Relationship with Jesus

LISTEN TOGETHER

Read Luke 10:25-37

- 1. Who should have stopped to help the man? (Parents, this may open up some interesting conversation about our inner prejudices. All of us are called by God to serve.)
- 2. Why should this person help more than the others?
- 3. What caused the Samaritan man to stop and help? (v.33)
- 4. The Samaritan man gave more than just a bandage. How does it make you feel knowing the Samaritan man gave generously to a total stranger? (v. 34-35)

LIVE IT

This Bible story is familiar to almost everyone. The Good Samaritan teaches us about serving one another. The Samaritan did three things for the man.

- 1. He noticed his need.
- 2. He met that need.
- 3. He provided a future path.

Two questions we should practice asking ourselves while we serve our family and others are:

Question 1: What does that person need?

Question 2: How does God want to me to help meet the need?
